## **MAPLE SUGARING AT CASS BENTON**

The calendar says it's spring, and the sap is flowing up the maple trees! Bundle up and join our naturalists at Cass Benton Park on Saturday, March 19 for a Maple Sugaring program. There are three different time slots to choose from (10 a.m., 11 a.m. or Noon) and the program lasts approximately 1 ½ hours. Cass Benton is located in Northville, off Northville road between Six Mile and Seven Mile Roads.

Learn how Native Americans were the first to discover that sap was a tasty treat, and taught early settlers how to collect and boil it. A short hike in the woods for a hands-on demonstration of tree tapping, sap collection and boiling is part of the fun. Information for backyard hobbyists is presented. Bring the whole family for a celebration of this enjoyable spring ritual. All ages welcome, but trail is not stroller friendly.
