GUIDELINES FOR WAYNE COUNTY SAFE SUMMER FUN POSTER & ESSAY CONTEST

1. Participants must be residents of Wayne County. Students ages 6 - 18 may enter. Three categories have been created: 6 - 10 years, 11 - 14 years, and 15 - 18 years. There will be three poster winners and three essay winners for each category. Students may enter either contest or both. A total of 18 students will receive prizes. Honorable mentions will be given.
2. All essays/posters should be on the topic of Safe Summer Family Fun (visualize "what does it look like to you).
3. Each poster or essay must have the following information written clearly on the back of the poster or attached to the essay: name, age, address, email, and school.
4. Posters must be done on standard 22" x 28' poster board or smaller. Students may use a variety of media, such as watercolor, pen and ink, crayon, chalk, markers, etc. Posters created by students must be their own original artwork. Copyrighted characters (such as Superman) or copyrighted clip art will not be accepted.
5. Essays must be no more than 500 words and have a descriptive title. Essays must be typed, double-spaced and printed only on one side of the paper.
